## **COLIN HIBBS RULES 2021 - 2022**

- 1. Each team must have must have at least one of each gender. Failure will result in a 25% reduction in the offending team's final score.
- 2. Players must be members of participating club, but do not have to be members of DIBC.
- 3. Green fees are £12 per team per game. There is no registration fee.
- 4. Winning team are awarded 2 points, Draw 1 point. If upon completion of the full program, two or more teams have the same number of points, shot difference will be taken into account to determine the overall winner and runner up.
- 5. A club failing to turn up, or cancelling a game, two points will be awarded to their opponents.
- 6. If due to weather conditions a game cannot be played, every effort should be made to re-arrange the game. The competition coordinator should be informed.

## **RULES OF PLAY**

- 7. All matches are played between 12:00 14:00 either Saturday or Sunday.
- 8. Teams are asked to arrive at least 15 minutes before start. Any team arriving more than 10 minutes after the advertised start time if game, will forfeit the game.
- 9. One shot on first two ends.
- 10. Maximum of 15 ends to be played, or until the siren sounds, whichever comes first.
- 11. Miss-cast jack, jack is positioned by opposing skip, opposing lead may reposition the mat.
- 12. If the jack goes off the rink during play, one shot will be awarded to the non-offending team, the end is counted as an end played.
- 13. Any team fielding only three players, will lose  $1/3^{rd}$  of their total score. The lead and second will bowl three bowls, the skip will bowl two.
- 14. Any team fielding two players, game will be conceded. Two points will be awarded to opposition.
- 15. Skips must leave the head together; they cannot revisit the head.

- 16. If in the unlikely event of an emergency, and the game having to be abandoned, the score will stand if five or more ends have been played, less than five ends, the game will be rescheduled.
- 17. Scorecards should be signed by both skips and returned to either the Saturday or Sunday Pidgeon hole adjacent to the reception desk.
- 18. Dress code, club shirts may be worn, otherwise it is white above the waist, grey below.
